All buses on this route are wheelchair accessible.



It's easy to ride to the State Fair – Here's how:

- 1 Look for the closest bus stop along the route.
- 2 Before getting on, check the route number in the sign above the windshield. Not sure the bus is the right one? Ask the driver.
- 3 Put your fare in the farebox next to the driver. You can use Go-To Cards, Metropasses, U-Passes, College Passes, Student Passes, SuperSavers, dollar bills, coins or tokens, but change is not available.
- 4 At the State Fairgrounds, wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before exiting. **If possible, exit through the back door.**

From the State Fair:

- 1 Return to the area where you were dropped off – the new State Fair Transit Hub, which is on the west side of the fairgrounds near the West End Market (formerly Heritage Square). Wait for your bus under the banner marked "Route 960."
- 2 Pay your fare. If you need to transfer to another route, ask the driver for a transfer. If you use a Go-To Card, Metropass, U-Pass, College Pass, Student Pass, or SuperSaver, a transfer is automatically embedded in your card when you pay your fare.
- 3 Take a seat and watch for your stop.
- 4 About one block from your stop, pull the cord above the window to signal the driver. **If possible, exit through the back door.**

Reduced Fares
Please tell the bus driver **before you pay your fare** if you qualify for a fare listed below. On rail, be ready to show police officers you qualify for the reduced fare.

These fares apply only during non-rush hours:
Seniors (65+): To qualify, show a Minnesota driver's license/state ID with a T endorsement.
Youth: Ages 6-12 qualify for a reduced fare.
Medicare card holders: To qualify, show a Medicare card along with a Minnesota driver's license/state ID.

These fares are in effect at all times:
Persons with Disabilities: To qualify, show your Metro Mobility card or transfer, Metro Transit temporary ID with a photo ID or Minnesota driver's license/state ID with an A or B endorsement. For information on certification, call Customer Relations at 612-373-3333.
Children: Ages 5 and under ride free (limit 3) when accompanied by a paid fare.
Downtown Zone: Ride in the Downtown Zone for 50¢.
Young Adults: Students and workers ages 17 and under may qualify for a discounted Young Adult Card – contact your school or employer.

Fare Cards Save money purchasing fare cards at Metro Transit stores, 175 retail outlets or at metrotransit.org.

Fareboxes Buses accept U.S. bills and coins. Change is not available.

Transfers give you unlimited rides on buses and METRO lines – for 2 1/2 hours. Ask for one when you pay your cash fare. Transfers are automatically embedded on fare cards and METRO line tickets.

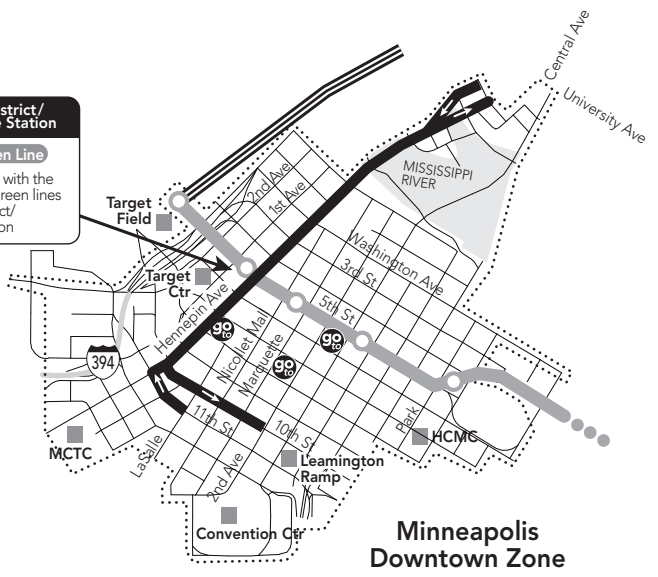

- Traffic and weather conditions may delay buses. This document is available in alternate formats to individuals with disabilities by calling 612-349-7365 (TTY 612-341-0140).

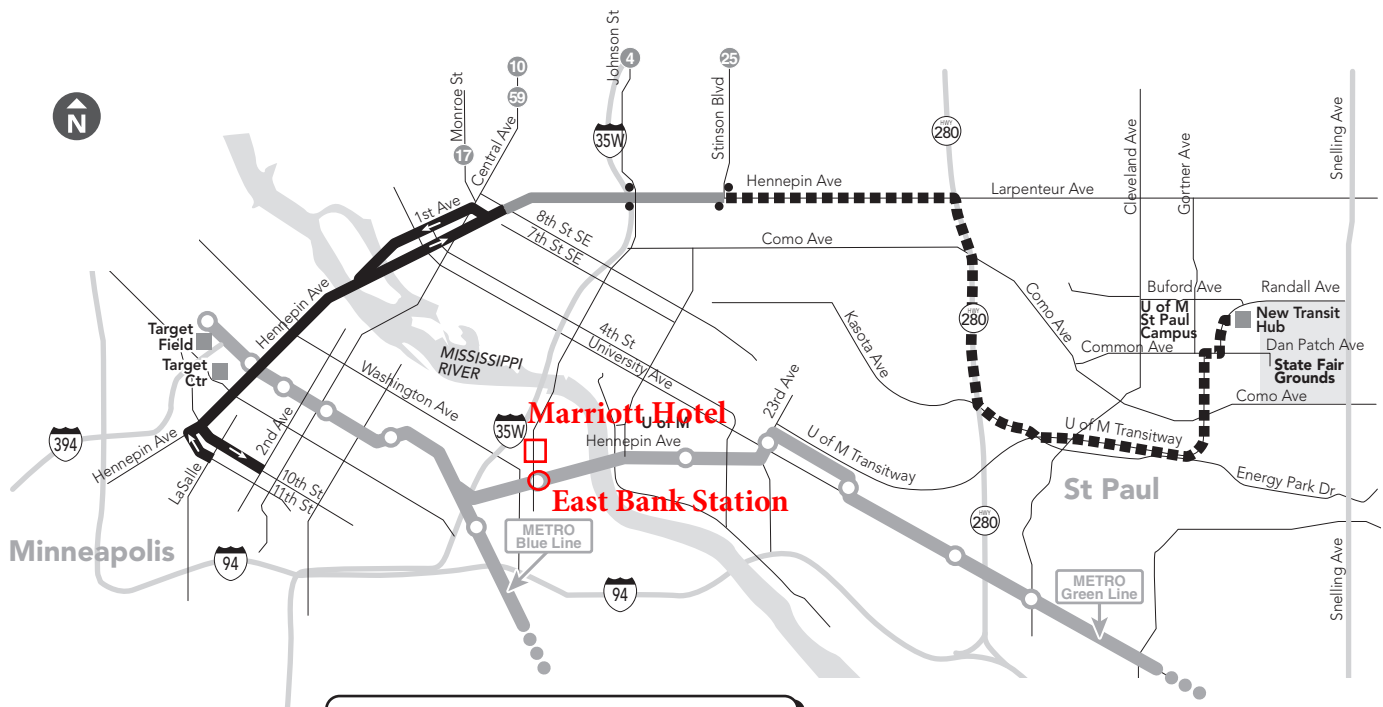

Approximate Bus Frequency

Minutes between buses on this route every day of the State Fair:

To the fair: 8 AM – 9 PM	Leaving the fair: noon – midnight
Approx. every 15 minutes	Approx. every 15 minutes

- Note:
- The first bus to the State Fairgrounds from Hennepin Ave is at **8 AM daily**.
 - The last bus leaving the State Fairgrounds is at **midnight daily**



Regular Route
Bus will pick up or drop off customers at any bus stop along this route.

METRO Line(s)
METRO trains and buses will pick up or drop off customers at any station along this line.

Northstar Line
Transfers from Northstar to light rail are free. Transfers from light rail to Northstar require an additional fare.

Non-Stop Service
Bus does not pick up or drop off customers on these route segments.

Limited Stop Service
Bus serves only designated bus stops.
